

## LBC Alumni to Raise Funds For Children

The [Leadership Blair County Alumni Association](#), a committee of the Blair County Chamber, will be launching a campaign called "Hope for Families" that will raise funds to purchase bedding as well as accepting bedding donations for needy children. This initiative replaces Basket of Hope. Bedding donations should include new bedding (pillows, pillow cases, comforters, sheets, blankets or even a complete bedding set) in neutral colors and gender neutral prints – twin size only. Monetary donations will be accepted with 100% used toward the purchase of bedding. The campaign goal is to provide bedding for 125 children, ages 5-16. Donations can be dropped off at the Chamber Office on August 29, 30, 31 and September 1 and 2 between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
