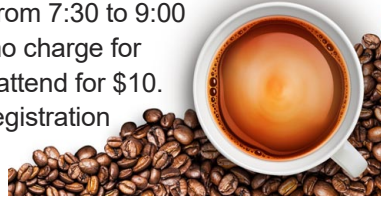


Mountain Lion Backpack to Host "Business Before Hours"
