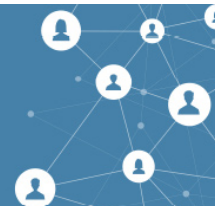

Farm Bureau VP to Speak at October "Breakfast Club"

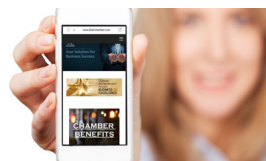
