

# Monumental Tax Reform Assisted by Chamber Effort

A piece of legislation that will make Pennsylvania more competitive as a business destination received a much-needed shot in the arm from chambers of commerce – including the Blair County Chamber – which advocated for its passage. Act 53 of 2022 improves Pennsylvania's economic competitiveness by proving relief to



small businesses along with immediate and continued reductions to the state's Corporate Net Income Tax (CNIT). By 2031, the end of the scheduled reductions, Pennsylvania's rate of 4.99% will be the sixth lowest in the nation.

# Small Businesses Should Be Alert to QuickBooks "Bug"

If your small business uses Quick-Books software, you need to be aware of a new "bug," according Thomas Gerlach, owner and senior engineer at Talixa Software & Service in Altoona. "There is a bug on the new invoice screen," Gerlach points out. "Unfortunately, if you click in the wrong text window, credit card payments will automatically be enabled." Gerlach has contacted the company with his findings and it is likely to take
