Applications are no longer being accepted for the 30th class of the Chamber's Leadership Blair County Adult program. The program has once again



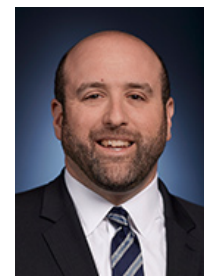
exceeded the number of applications needed to hit the maximum number of 24 class members. Interviews for all applicants will take place during August.

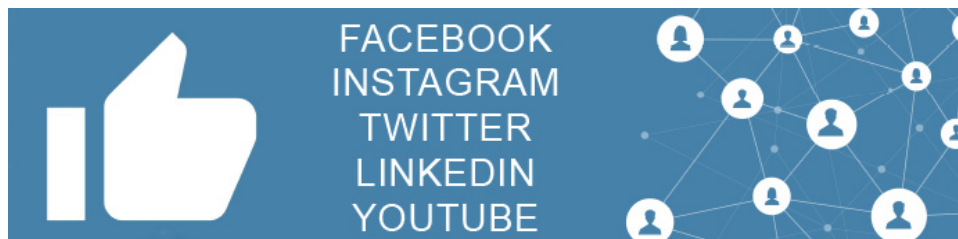
Although the Blair County Chamber doesn't have a Breakfast Club during July, the program on August 8th will be one that the business community won't want to miss. The speaker at
