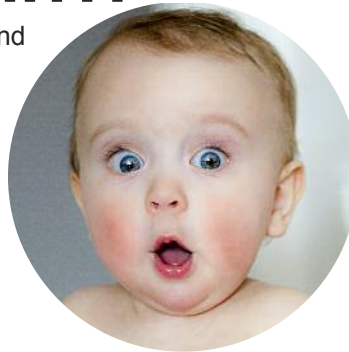

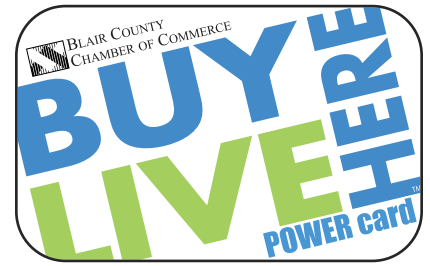
an integral part of the Chamber's Early Childhood effort, even convening meetings to discuss ways to mobilize the business community to assist in creating awareness of the county's future workforce.

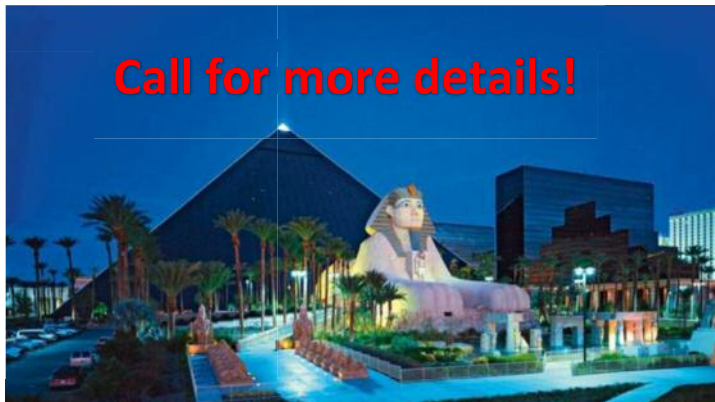
